- **Long-Term Value and Stewardship:** Will the project continue to provide enduring benefits for residents, wildlife, and Colorado's natural resources in the years ahead?
- **Alignment with the Lottery's Mission:** Does the project exemplify the responsible and purposeful use of Lottery funds - turning play into public good and investing in the future of Colorado's outdoors?
