## Colorado Lottery wins big during \$1.8 billion Powerball jackpot run

Coloradans won more than \$23 million in prizes, with more than 22 winning \$50,000 to \$2 million, from June 1 to Sept. 6

PUEBLO, Colo. -- A Colorado Lottery player didn't snag the record-breaking \$1.8 billion Powerball® jackpot, but the state of Colorado still won big.

From June 1 through Sept. 6, the Lottery awarded about \$23 million in prizes, with 22 players winning \$50,000 to \$2 million. Players helped the Lottery generate more than \$47 million in Powerball sales that stay right in the Colorado economy.

Retailers benefited too, earning nearly \$3 million in commissions from Powerball sales alone. Because big jackpots also boost sales of other games, total retailer commissions across all products topped \$17 million statewide.

Most importantly, Colorado communities came out on top. This Powerball run delivered \$14.5 million in Lottery proceeds to fund parks, trails, open space, wildlife conservation, outdoor accessibility, and school infrastructure across the state.

The Colorado Lottery is the only lottery in the nation that gives back the majority of its proceeds to the outdoors and also gives back to school infrastructure projects through Building Excellent Schools Today (BEST). Lottery proceeds are distributed to Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO), invests in parks, trails, open spaces, and wildlife habitat. Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) supports 42 state parks and protects wildlife management and conservation programs. BEST improves safety and modernizes schools across the state. Outdoor Equity Grant Program (OEGP) helps expand access for youth and underserved communities to outdoor experiences. Colorado Outdoor Recreation Industry Office (OREC) drives outdoor accessibility, connectivity, and recreation-based economies.





"Even when the jackpot lands elsewhere, Colorado always wins," said Senior Director Tom Seaver of the Colorado Lottery. "Every ticket sold means funding for trails, schools, wildlife, and access to the outdoors. This is the heart of our mission."
