Colorado Lottery Announces That Loverboy Has Canceled State Fair Concert

Pueblo, Colo. - The Colorado Lottery has been notified that Loverboy has canceled its Colorado State Fair concert planned for Sunday, Sept. 5. There will be three conversion options for current ticket holders and those with vouchers.

Loverboy concert ticket holders can exchange their tickets for Diamond Rio tickets, scheduled for 7 p.m., Sunday, Aug. 29, at the Bud Light Grandstand. This also includes general gate admission on this date, but does not include entrance to the rodeo.

Ticket holders may also exchange their tickets for George Thorogood tickets for Thursday, Sept. 2, 7 p.m., at the Southwest Motors Event Center, also including general admission on the same day.

The option to convert tickets to one of these two concerts will be available while ticket supplies last. Lastly, Loverboy ticket holders may also exchange tickets for general admission fair tickets any day, Aug. 27 - Sept. 6, 2021. The exchange and redemption options will be open for conversion beginning on Aug. 20 at www.coloradostatefair.com.

While Loverboy will not be playing on the second Sunday of the State Fair, upwards of 60 entertainers will be performing throughout the week. Also, Sunday, Sept. 5, is Colorado Lottery day, where guests receive \$3 off the general admission ticket price, paying just \$9 if they bring a non-winning Lottery ticket.
