Colorado Lottery Announces Powerball and Mega Millions Jackpots Roll to more than \$900 Million Combined

Pueblo, CO -- Jackpots have been rolling for Colorado Lottery Powerball and Mega Millions. Tonight's Powerball drawing is the highest jackpot since January when dueling jackpot runs produced a \$731.1 million Powerball jackpot won in Maryland and a \$1.05 billion Mega Millions jackpot won in Michigan. Tonight's Powerball Jackpot is \$472 Million and Tuesday's Mega Millions Jackpot is expected to be \$432 Million, totaling a combined \$904 million.

With Powerball Double Play® players can play their same Powerball numbers in an additional drawing with a top prize of \$10 million for an additional \$1. The Powerball Power Play® add-on feature is also available for an additional \$1 per play to multiply non-jackpot prizes and will only apply to prizes won in the primary Powerball drawing.

"Dueling Jackpot runs like these get players excited and play a major role in allowing us to hit our Great Outdoors Colorado proceeds cap early," said Colorado Lottery director Tom Seaver. "That triggers additional funding for our other partners like Building Excellent Schools Today and the newly created Outdoor Equity fund."

Mega Millions and Powerball tickets are \$2 each and can be purchased at Lottery retailers throughout the state. Mega Millions drawings are held every Tuesday and Friday at 9:00 p.m. MT. Powerball drawings are held every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday at 8:59 p.m. MT.

The cutoff to buy tickets both days is 7:30 p.m. MT.
