



ULTIMATE DASH® SHOPPING SPREE BONUS SECOND CHANCE PROMOTIONAL DRAWING GUIDELINES

I. OVERVIEW

These guidelines shall govern the Bonus Internet Drawing to be conducted by the Colorado Lottery as part of the **ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree Scratch Game**.

To enter the drawing, players must register the 22-digit Void If Removed Number (VIRN) from any non-winning **\$10 ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree Scratch Game** ticket on the Colorado Lottery's Website (www.coloradolottery.com) or scan the barcode on non-winning tickets with the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Application. The VIRN and the scannable barcode are located on the front of the ticket, under the scratch-off portion.

Bonus Internet Drawing: There will be one (1) drawing where six (6) prizewinners (the "Prizewinner" or "Prizewinners") will be selected to win an ULTIMATE DASH® Event promotional prize (each a "Dash Event Prize"). The Dash Event Prize is a three-day, two-night trip for the Prizewinners and one (1) guest or assigned proxy to Denver, Colorado, to participate in a Dash Event to collect as much merchandise as they can into their shopping cart. The Dash Event will conclude with a bonus prize round (the "Bonus Prize Round"), to give each Prizewinner the opportunity to choose one (1) box out of six (6) for a chance to win between one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and up to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

II. PURPOSE

- A. To ensure the prize awarded in the **ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree Scratch Game Bonus Internet Drawing** is determined as impartially and randomly as practical.
- B. To ensure the integrity of the Colorado Lottery is maintained at all times.
- C. To ensure the drawing is conducted in strict compliance with guidelines for Colorado Lottery Bonus Internet Drawings.
- D. To ensure compliance with all applicable State of Colorado and Colorado Lottery Statutes, Rules, and Regulations.

III. TOP PRIZE

- A. **The Dash Event:** One (1) three-day, two-night trip for the Lottery Prizewinners and one (1) guest to Denver, Colorado to occur on or about October 2026. The dates and

location are subject to change. Each Trip Prize includes:

- i. Travel allowance for the Prizewinner and guest or assigned proxy provided two (2) weeks before the scheduled event date;
 - ii. All ground transfers between the event location and destination hotel in Denver, Colorado, and, if necessary, between Scientific Games, LLC ("SG" or "Contractor") hosted events;
 - iii. One (1) double occupancy deluxe room accommodation (room and room tax only) at a 3-star or better hotel in Denver, Colorado, for two (2) nights;
 - iv. A welcome reception for the Prizewinner and guest;
 - v. Admission for two (2) to the ULTIMATE DASH® Event (the "Dash Event"), where the Prizewinner and their one (1) guest or assigned proxy will have ninety-seconds (:90) to collect as much merchandise as they can into their shopping cart during the Dash Event as further described in the Addendum.
 - vi. At the conclusion of the Dash Event, the Prizewinners will participate in the Bonus Prize Round, where they will be given an opportunity to select one (1) box out of six (6) for a chance to win between one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and up to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) (guests will not participate in the Bonus Prize Round).
 - a. Prize Winner is responsible for claiming all winnings from the Bonus Prize Round. The Bonus Prize Round winnings will be a taxes paid prize.
 - b. Must be claimed at one of the four (4) Colorado Lottery claim centers.
 - vii. One (1) check for one thousand dollars (\$1,000) spending money, provided two (2) weeks before the scheduled Dash Event;
 - viii. For tax withholding valuation purposes, the trip portion of the Dash Event Prize is estimated to be valued at Three Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$3,350), including state and federal tax withholdings, Based on 2026 withholding rates, the federal tax withholdings are estimated to be valued at One Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Ninety-One Cents (\$1,122.91) and the state tax withholdings are estimated to be valued at Two Hundred Five Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$205.87) and are subject to rate changes at the time the Dash Event Prize is claimed. Contractor shall withhold the state and federal tax withholdings and shall pay the appropriate agency on behalf of each Prizewinner and provide them with an IRS Tax Form 1099. All costs and expenses associated with the Dash Event Prize, not specified herein as being provided, incurred by the Prizewinner when using the Dash Event Prize, such as transportation costs, fees, additional parking, additional food and beverages, souvenirs, gratuities, and other expenses incurred, are the sole responsibility of the Prizewinner.
- B. Odds of winning a drawing prize are dependent on the number of eligible entries registered for this Bonus Internet Drawing by the Colorado Lottery Database Provider as of the designated deadline for the drawing.

- C. There is no cash option for a Dash Event Prize.
- D. All prizes won by Prizewinners during the Dash Event may be subject to Lottery debt set-off procedures.
- E. A Prizewinner may not choose to receive the cash equivalent of the trip portion of the Dash Event Prize or its merchandise.

IV. DRAWING DATE AND LOCATION

- A. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee shall determine the game end date.
- B. The drawing date will be August 11, 2026; the drawing eligibility deadlines and drawing dates will be posted on www.coloradolottery.com. The dates are subject to change at the Colorado Lottery Director or designee's discretion.
- C. The drawing will be held at a time and location to be determined by the Drawing Manager or designee. The drawing is open to the public.

V. ELIGIBILITY

- A. All entries must be received and registered by the Colorado Lottery Database Provider in order to qualify for the drawing by the deadline.
- B. In order to qualify for the drawing, players must register non-winning tickets from the scratch game designated in Section I of these guidelines.
- C. A player can only win one (1) Bonus Internet Drawing Prize.
- D. Each qualified non-winning **\$10, ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree** Scratch Game ticket will qualify as one (1) entry only into the drawing.
- E. There is no limit to the number of unique entries that can be submitted by a single player.
- F. In order to register a qualified non-winning ticket as an entry on the website, the unique 22-digit Void If Removed Number (VIRN) located on the front of the **\$10 ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree** Scratch Game ticket, the player's name, current address (street, city, state, and zip code), date of birth, email address and telephone number are required.
- G. Registration of qualified non-winning tickets at the Colorado Lottery's Website, www.coloradolottery.com, and the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Application are the only methods of entry into the drawing. Entries submitted through any other method will not be eligible. The **\$10 ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree** Scratch Game tickets are Internet Registration Entries.
- H. Mail-in entries will not be accepted. In addition, non-winning tickets may not be forwarded to the Colorado Lottery via Colorado Lottery Retailers, Colorado Lottery Offices, Colorado Lottery Staff, special events, courier, or any other exceptional means. The Colorado Lottery does not accept responsibility for incorrectly submitted, lost, stolen, or non-received entries.
- I. Winning tickets and tickets identified as stolen are not eligible to win a prize in this drawing. The Lottery will utilize all reasonably available means to identify stolen tickets.
- J. An entry is ineligible if the person whose name is contained in the entry is ineligible to receive a Colorado Lottery Prize as referenced in C.R.S. 44-40-113 (5) or pursuant to the Colorado Lottery Rules. Prize eligibility is subject to any and all applicable statutes, rules, and regulations regarding participation in Colorado Lottery Games.

1. The following persons are not eligible to participate in the drawings:
 2. Members of the Colorado Lottery Commission or their Immediate Families;
 3. Employees of the Colorado Lottery's independent auditing firms;
 4. Employees of the Colorado Lottery or their Immediate Families, except when authorized by the Director for investigative purposes. But, in no event shall such persons be entitled to payment of a Prize;
 5. Employees of Scientific Games, LLC. ("SG"), BSL Brightstar Lottery, Cactus Communications, Fusionbox, Inc., HINDA, INC. ("HINDA"), and each of their respective parent and affiliated companies, subsidiaries, licensees, divisions, members, or any employee of a Vendor of the Colorado Lottery or an employee of a Vendor's subcontractor whose job responsibilities could reasonably pose a risk to the Colorado Lottery, including but not limited to, employees whose job duties include the marketing, development, operation, or security of a Colorado Lottery product or related system; Any Immediate Family member of an employee referenced above;
 6. Persons who operate Drawing equipment during a Drawing or officially witnesses a Drawing and members of their Immediate Family.
 7. Any other individual who is regularly ineligible to participate in Colorado Lottery Games; and
 8. Immediate, resident family members of any of the foregoing.
- K. Prizewinner and guest or assigned proxy agree to sign waivers of liability releasing the Colorado Lottery, SG and HINDA from liability during the Dash Event. Each Prizewinner or their proxy and their guest must also sign waivers agreeing to allow the Colorado Lottery to use their image, pictures, videos, and interviews taken in conjunction with the Dash Event.
- L. Prizewinner and guest or assigned proxy consent to be filmed, photographed, or otherwise recorded, and to the use of such content by the Lottery for promotional purposes, including but not limited to social media, Lottery-owned channels, and media outreach.
- M. Prizewinner and guest or assigned proxy will consent to a background investigation, derived from public information, before departure to the Dash Event. Such background investigation shall be conducted by the Scientific Games, LLC security team.
- N. The Prizewinner or guest or assigned proxy must have a valid credit card or shall be required to post a cash deposit for the incidentals to check into the hotel. Subject to hotel policy, the minimum age to check into the hotel may be eighteen (18) or twenty-one (21) years of age.
- O. Age and other eligibility requirements shall be determined by the Lottery, however the minimum age to participate in the Dash Event as a Prizewinner and guest or assigned proxy, shall be eighteen (18) years of age.
- P. The Colorado Lottery reserves the right to end the **\$10 ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree** Scratch Game at any time. Entries received after the submission deadline into the **ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree INTERNET DRAWING** have no expressed or implied value. The Colorado Lottery bears no obligation or liability for such entries.
- Q. If the Colorado Lottery determines an entry to be valid, and the entry was not entered into the drawing due to Colorado Lottery or the Database Provider error, as determined by the Colorado Lottery Director or designee, that entry may be entered into a comparable drawing

for prizes of like value, or an alternate prize may be offered at a future time to be determined by the Colorado Lottery Director or designee. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee's decision is final.

- R. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee will make all final decisions regarding the eligibility of entries and/or participants.
- S. Any attempt to deliberately damage the Colorado Lottery Website or undermine the legitimate operations of the Promotional Internet Drawing is a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, the Colorado Lottery reserves the right to disqualify any portion of, or the entire, registration database.
- T. Participants in this promotion agree to be bound by these Official Rules.

VI. HANDLING AND STORAGE OF ENTRIES

- A. Entries received at www.coloradolottery.com or through the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Scratch Application will be compiled and stored in a database.
- B. A unique number will be assigned to each entry.
- C. After the eligibility deadline for the drawing has expired, the database provider will secure the database such that no new entries are recorded.

VII. DRAWING PREPARATIONS

A. SUPPLIES

- 1. Random number generator (computer program or alternate method).
- 2. Drawing checklists and certification forms.
- 3. Database containing all of the entries registered at www.coloradolottery.com or through the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Scratch Application during the drawing eligibility period and up to the drawing deadline.

B. PERSONNEL

The Drawing Team will consist, minimally, of the Lottery Drawing Manager or designee and Colorado Lottery Security Personnel.

1. Drawing Manager Responsibilities:

- a. Ensure all necessary equipment and supplies are available and in good working order.
- c. Ensure that all required personnel are present, briefed, and prepared to conduct the drawing.
- d. Ensure that all required documents, checklists, and certification forms are completed in a timely manner.
- e. Supervise staff in their drawing assignments.
- f. Ensure that the drawing is under camera for Colorado Lottery security purposes.
- g. Using a random number generator, select the winning entry or entries.
- h. Halt the drawing if anything improper is observed.

- i. Approve continuation of the drawing once an observed problem is corrected.
- 2. Independent Auditor Responsibilities:
 - a. Observe all aspects of the drawing and bring any improprieties or irregularities to the attention of the Drawing Manager or designee.
 - b. Examine equipment and supplies (pre- and post-drawing) to ensure operation will not compromise the integrity of the drawing.
 - c. Assist in examination of selected entries.
 - d. Halt the drawing if anything improper is observed.
 - e. Inspect and sign certified drawing documents.
 - f. Provide a report to the Drawing Manager or designee to certify that the drawing has been held in compliance with all applicable statutes, rules, and guidelines.
- 3. Colorado Lottery Security Personnel Responsibilities:
 - a. Security Personnel must be present for all public viewings.
 - b. Observe all aspects of the drawing, ensuring that nothing is tampered with.
 - c. Assist in examination and validation of each entry.
 - d. Oversee verification of winner identification and eligibility.
 - e. Halt the drawing if anything improper is observed.

VIII. DRAWING PROCEDURES

- A. The Drawing Team will assemble at the drawing site on the date and time determined by the Drawing Manager or designee.
- B. The drawing may not proceed until the appropriate personnel described in Section VII.B. are present.
- C. The Drawing Team will inspect the drawing equipment to ensure it is operating properly. The equipment should show no signs of tampering or any other condition that might compromise the integrity or fairness of the drawing.
- D. The database will consist of uniquely numbered entries that include registration information for the person that submitted the entry.
- E. The Drawing Manager or designee shall utilize a random number generator, as described in Section VII.A.1., to select entries within the “from-to” range. The entry corresponding to the first (1st) selected number shall be the Prizewinner and the remaining entries selected shall be the alternates, in the order selected.
 - 1. Bonus Internet Drawing: The entries corresponding to the first (1st) numbers selected will be the Prizewinner for the Bonus Internet Drawing, the second (2nd), third (3rd) and fourth (4th) numbers selected shall be the alternates, in the order selected.
 - 2. The Drawing Manager or designee will determine the number of alternate entries

to be selected at the time of the drawing.

- F. Once the random numbers have been selected, the Drawing Manager or designee will access the database to determine the entry corresponding to the first (1st) selected random number and thus the Prizewinner and alternates for the drawing. A printout of the winner and alternate entries shall be placed into the drawing file.
- G. Should it be necessary for the Colorado Lottery to conduct a subsequent drawing after the official drawing, a Drawing Team will re-assemble.
- H. Should any member of the Drawing Team observe the occurrence of anything unusual during the drawing process that cannot be immediately corrected and may affect the validity of the drawing, that member may immediately halt the drawing proceedings. The Drawing Team shall attempt to resolve the issue and continue the drawing. In absence of a resolution, the Drawing Manager or designee shall attempt to contact the Colorado Lottery Director, Deputy Director, Security Director, and/or Marketing Director, in that order. The decision of the contacted Director is final. Should the decision of the Director be to halt the drawing, the Drawing Team shall immediately secure the entry database, equipment and supplies until the drawing can re-commence. An Incident Report must be completed by the Drawing Manager or designee and included with the drawing forms.
- I. Following completion of the drawing, the Drawing Team will inspect and secure the equipment.

IX. DETERMINATION OF WINNER

- A. A reasonable attempt will be made to contact the person contained in the registered entry. If an entry is deemed preliminarily eligible at the time of the drawing, but the Colorado Lottery is unable to contact the person for any reason (e.g. telephone number or email address is incorrect or no longer in service) within five (5) business days, the prize is awarded to the alternate(s) in the order drawn. At the discretion of the Drawing Manager, the timeframe may be extended.
- B. The person will have five (5) business days after being notified of the selection of their entry to contact the Colorado Lottery and claim their prize. At the discretion of the Drawing Manager, the timeframe may be extended.
- C. If the winning entry contains more than one name, each person will be contacted and required to fill out a Relinquishment of Rights Form. Should this form be properly completed by each person the entry may be deemed eligible. In such an instance, each person will have five (5) business days from the date of claim to provide the completed form to the Colorado Lottery. If for any reason, the form is not completed and provided to the Colorado Lottery, the entry may be deemed ineligible.
- D. Should the winning entry be deemed ineligible for any reason, the first alternate shall replace it as the winning entry. This entry will then be subjected to the same eligibility requirements, and should it also be deemed ineligible, replaced by the second alternate. This process will be repeated until an entry has been determined eligible and certified as the winner.
- E. In the event there is an inconsistency or insufficient information as to the person(s) entitled to the prize, the Colorado Lottery Director or designee shall initiate an investigation and withhold all winnings until such time that the Director or designee is satisfied that the proper person is awarded the prize.
- F. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee shall make all final decisions regarding the

eligibility of entries and/or participants.

X. FULFILLMENT OF PRIZE(S)

- A. Prizewinner eligibility in the **ULTIMATE DASH® Shopping Spree Scratch Game Bonus Internet Drawing** is subject to any and all applicable State of Colorado and Colorado Lottery Statutes, Rules, and Regulations regarding participation in Colorado Lottery Games.
- B. The payee of a prize of \$600 or more shall be subject to intercept procedures outlined in C.R.S. 44-40-113 and 44-40-114.
- C. By entering this drawing, you are allowing the Colorado Lottery to display your first name, last initial, and city on the Colorado Lottery Website if your entry is selected as a winner.
- D. Prizewinner and guest consent to be filmed, photographed, or otherwise recorded in association with the Dash Event, and to the use of such content by the Lottery for promotional purposes, including but not limited to social media, the Lottery website, and media outreach.
- E. All Prizewinners are required to submit a claim form and claim their prize at one 1 of the four 4 Colorado Lottery offices.
- F. The prize is non-transferable, non-refundable, and cannot be redeemed for cash or substituted for any other product or service.

ADDENDUM DASH EVENT PRIZE SPECIFICATIONS

Each Colorado Lottery Prizewinner (each a “Prizewinner” or an assigned proxy, as described in Section III(a) above, shall participate in the ULTIMATE DASH® Event (the “Dash Event”). Each Prizewinner and their one (1) guest will participate in a ninety second (:90) DASH through the Dash Event course to place as much merchandise as they can successfully into their shopping cart.

- The Dash Event will consist of six (6) 2-person teams (each a “Team”) participating, each consisting of one (1) Prizewinner and the Prizewinner’s one (1) guest.
- The Prizewinner’s guest will assist him or her in the “Dash Event Course”. Each Team will be supplied with a minimum of one (1) empty cart (40” long, 27” wide and 30” high).
- One (1) Team member will be the dedicated “pusher”, and the other Team member will be the dedicated “picker”. Please note, the “pusher” can rearrange items in the cart but may NOT pull items from the shelves. Any item pulled, picked or otherwise removed from the shelves by the “pusher” shall not be included as a “picked” item, and shall not be included in the prizes won or awarded during the Dash Event unless “picker” also pulls and places the item in the cart.
- Each Team will have fifteen (15) minutes before the Dash Event to walk aisles designated as the “Dash Event Course” and to develop their plan for which merchandise items they wish to select.
- Marking or tagging of the merchandise, floor, racking, etc., before the start of the Dash Event is not allowed.
- Only one (1) Team will be on the “Dash Event Course” at a time. When the Team is ready, an air horn will sound to alert the Team that they may begin and stop watches will start with ninety seconds (:90) on the clock. The Team may begin to dash up and down the aisle(s) putting as much merchandise into the cart as possible.
- A Team member may only select a single quantity of each item. If more than one (1) of any item is grabbed, the extras will be returned to the shelf.
- Referees will be stationed throughout the “Dash Event Course” with stop watches to alert the Team of their remaining Dash Event time. When the Team’s ninety seconds (:90) is up, a referee will inform them, and another air horn will sound to alert the Team to stop. At this time, no more items can be “picked”.
- The Team will then take their cart(s) to the designated area where all items selected will be verified immediately by a staff member.

- The Prizewinner shall be allowed to keep all items the “picker” placed in their cart (hereinafter the “Dash Event Prizes”).
- Each Prizewinner will be provided a list of their Dash Event Prizes for review prior to their departure from the warehouse. The Dash Event Prizes will be shipped to each Prizewinner within twenty (20) business days following the Dash Event. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event there is a delay in shipment and/or Dash Event Prize(s) become unavailable at time of shipping, the Prizewinner will be notified, and a Dash Event Prize of like or similar value will be substituted.

BONUS PRIZE ROUND

At the conclusion of the Dash Event, the Lottery will line all six (6) Prizewinners up for a bonus prize round (the “Bonus Prize Round”). The Lottery will randomly draw the six (6) Prizewinners’ names to line up from 1 – 6. This line up will be the order in which each Prizewinner will select a sealed box (the “Bonus Prize Box”). Each Bonus Prize Box will randomly contain one of the following prizes:

- One (1) \$10,000 Prize
- One (1) \$5,000 Prize
- One (1) \$3,000 Prize
- Three (3) \$1,000 Prizes

The combined total Bonus Prize Box value is twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000.00),

The Lottery will provide a mock check representing the value from the Bonus Prize Box chosen by each Prizewinner. The Prizewinners will be responsible for taking the mock check to a Lottery claims center to officially process the Bonus Prize value amount.

The **ULTIMATE DASH®** is administered by Scientific Games, LLC (“SG” or “Contractor”). Any questions regarding the **ULTIMATE DASH®**, including questions regarding the assignment of proxies, prize payments, and tax liability or withholding for Dash Event Prizes, should be directed to SG at 1-800-201-0108. Participation in the **ULTIMATE DASH®** may be subject to other local, state, and federal laws, including the laws of the State of Colorado.
