



DENVER BRONCOS INTERNET PROMOTIONAL DRAWING GUIDELINES GAME #426 BRONCOS BLITZ

I. OVERVIEW

These guidelines shall govern the Internet Promotional Drawing (the "Drawing") to be conducted by the Colorado Lottery as part of the **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** Scratch game. The promotion entry start date will be August 3, 2026, at 6:00:00 am and the entry deadline will be December 5, 2026, at 23:59:59.

To enter the drawing, players must register the 22-digit Void If Removed Number (VIRN) from **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** non-winning tickets on the Colorado Lottery's Website (www.coloradolottery.com) or scan the barcode on non-winning tickets with the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Application. The VIRN is located on the front of the ticket under the scratch-off portion of the ticket.

Drawing: There will be one (1) drawing on December 8th, 2026, during which 11 winners will be selected.

One (1) first-place winner (the "**Grand Prize Winner**") will be selected to win a VIP Home Game Experience (Value \$15,000) for the Denver Broncos' final regular-season home game of the 2026 NFL season in Denver, Colorado. The VIP Home Game Experience package includes for the winner and their One (1) guest, dinner with Broncos alumni the night before the game, premium hotel accommodations in downtown Denver, premium ground transportation to and from the game, VIP tailgate tickets, a pre-game meet-and-greet with Miles the Mascot and the Denver Broncos Cheerleaders, pre-game field passes, Bud Light Champions Club game tickets for the final home game of the 2026 NFL season, and post-game press conference access passes with a photo opportunity.

Two (2) second-place winners ("**First runner-up**") will each be selected to win (1) pair (2) of 100-level Denver Broncos Season Tickets (Value \$2,230 per ticket) for the 2027 NFL season (i.e., the NFL season commencing in calendar year 2027 and concluding with Super Bowl LXII).

Two (2) third-place winners ("**Second runner-up**") will each be selected to win one (1) pair (2) 300-level Denver Broncos Season Tickets (Value \$1,420 per ticket) for the 2027 NFL season (i.e., the NFL season commencing in calendar year 2027 and concluding with Super Bowl LXII).

Six (6) fourth-place winners ("**Third runner-up**") will each be selected to win one (1) pair

(2) 500-level Denver Broncos Season Tickets (Value \$1,250 per ticket) for the 2027 NFL season (i.e., the NFL season commencing in calendar year 2027 and concluding with Super Bowl LXII).

II. PURPOSE

- A. To ensure the prizes awarded in the **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** Internet Promotional Drawing are determined as impartially and randomly as practical.
- B. To ensure the integrity of the Colorado Lottery is maintained at all times.
- C. To ensure the Drawing is conducted in strict compliance with guidelines for Colorado Lottery Promotional Internet Drawings.
- D. To ensure compliance with all applicable State of Colorado and Colorado Lottery Statutes, Rules, and Regulations.

III. PRIZE (S)

- A. **GRAND PRIZE BRONCOS BLITZ NFL VIP Last Home Game of the 2026 Experience includes:**

Experience includes: (I) dinner with Bronco's alumni the night before game; (II) premium hotel accommodations in downtown Denver; (III) premium ground transportation to and from game; (IV) VIP tailgate tickets; (V) Miles the Mascot and Denver Broncos Cheerleaders meet-and-greet pregame; (VI) pre-game field passes; (VII) Bud Light Champions Club game tickets; (VIII) post-game press conference access and photo opportunity.

- B. **SECOND PRIZE:**

Two (2) winners will be selected to win a pair (2) of 100 level 2027/2028 Denver Broncos season tickets (Value \$2,230 per ticket).

- C. **THIRD PRIZE**

Two (2) Winners will be selected to win a pair (2) of 300 level 2027/2028 Denver Broncos season tickets (Value \$1,420 per ticket).

- D. **FOURTH PRIZE**

Six (6) winners will be selected to win a pair (2) of 500 level 2027/2028 Denver Broncos Season tickets (Value \$1,250 per ticket).

- E. Season tickets are only valid for the 2027 Denver Broncos Season and are not eligible for repurchase or renewal after the 2027 Denver Broncos Season.
- F. Odds of winning a Drawing Prize are dependent on the number of eligible entries in the Internet Promotional Drawing Conducted by the Colorado Lottery on the designated deadline for the Drawing.

IV. DRAWING DATE AND LOCATION

- A. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee shall determine the game end date.
- B. The eligibility deadlines and Drawing dates will be posted on www.coloradolottery.com. The dates and locations are subject to change at the Colorado Lottery Director or designee's discretion.
- C. The Drawing will be held at a time and location to be determined by the Drawing Manager or designee. The drawing is open to the public. Members of the public wishing to attend the drawing must contact the Colorado Lottery Drawing Manager to schedule and make arrangements. Unannounced attendees will not be granted access to the drawing facility.

V. ELIGIBILITY

- A. All entries must be received and registered by the Colorado Lottery Database Provider in order to qualify for the Drawing by the deadline.
- B. A player who wins a higher-tier prize will not be eligible for a lower-tier prize.
- C. In order to qualify for the drawing, players must register non-winning tickets from the scratch game designated in Section I of these guidelines.
- D. Each qualified **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** Scratch ticket will qualify as one (1) entry only into the drawing.
- E. There is no limit to the number of entries that can be submitted by a single player.
- F. In order to register a qualified non-winning ticket as an entry on the website, the unique 22-digit Void If Removed Number (VIRN) located on the front of the **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** ticket, the player's name, current address (street, city, state, and zip code), date of birth, email, and telephone number are required.
- G. Registration of qualified non-winning tickets at the Colorado Lottery's Website, www.coloradolottery.com, and the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Application are the only methods of entry into the drawing. Entries submitted through any other method will not be eligible. The **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** Scratch Tickets are Internet Registration Entries.
- H. Mail-in entries will not be accepted. In addition, tickets may not be forwarded to the Colorado Lottery via Colorado Lottery Retailers, Colorado Lottery Offices, Colorado Lottery Staff, special events, courier, or any other exceptional means. The Colorado Lottery does not accept responsibility for incorrectly submitted, lost, stolen, or unreceived entries.
- I. Stolen tickets are not eligible to win a prize in this drawing. The Lottery will utilize all reasonably available means to identify stolen tickets.
- J. An entry is ineligible if the person whose name is contained in the entry is ineligible to receive a Colorado Lottery Prize as referenced in C.R.S. 44-40-113 (5) or pursuant to the Colorado Lottery Rules. Prize eligibility is subject to any and all applicable statutes, rules, and regulations regarding participation in Colorado Lottery Games.

1. The following persons are not eligible to participate in the drawings:
 2. Members of the Colorado Lottery Commission or their Immediate Families;
 3. Employees of the Colorado Lottery's independent auditing firms;
 4. Employees of the Colorado Lottery or their Immediate Families, except when authorized by the Director for investigative purposes. But, in no event shall such persons be entitled to payment of a Prize;
 - i. Employees of Scientific Games, LLC. ("SG"), Brightstar Lottery, Cactus Communications, Fusionbox, Inc., or any employee of a Vendor of the Colorado Lottery or an employee of a Vendor's subcontractor whose job responsibilities could reasonably pose a risk to the Colorado Lottery, including but not limited to, employees whose job duties include the marketing, development, operation, or security of a Colorado Lottery product or related system; Any Immediate Family member of an employee referenced above; and
 5. Persons who operate Drawing equipment during a Drawing or officially witness a Drawing and members of their Immediate Family.
 6. Any other individual who is regularly ineligible to participate in Colorado Lottery Games; and
 7. Immediate, resident family members of any of the foregoing.
- K. Individuals must be at least 18 years of age.
- L. The Colorado Lottery reserves the right to end **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** at any time. Entries received after the submission deadline into the **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ Internet Promotional Drawing** have no expressed or implied value. The Colorado Lottery bears no obligation or liability for such entries.
- M. If the Colorado Lottery determines an entry to be valid, and the entry was not entered into the drawing due to a Colorado Lottery error, as determined by the Colorado Lottery Director or designee, that entry may be entered into a comparable drawing for prizes of like value, or an alternate prize may be offered at a future time to be determined by the Colorado Lottery Director or designee. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee's decision is final.
- N. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee will make all final decisions regarding the eligibility of entries and/or participants.
- O. Any attempt to deliberately damage the Colorado Lottery drawing equipment or undermine the legitimate operations of the Internet Promotional Drawing is a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, the Colorado Lottery reserves the right to disqualify any portion of or the entire number of entries.
- P. Prizewinner and guest consent to be filmed, photographed, or otherwise recorded, and to the use of such content by the Lottery for promotional purposes, including but not limited to social media, Lottery-owned channels, and media outreach.

VI. HANDLING AND STORAGE OF ENTRIES

- A. Entries received at www.coloradolottery.com or through the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Scratch Application will be compiled and stored in a database.

- B. A unique number will be assigned to each entry.
- C. After the eligibility deadline for the drawing has expired, the database provider will secure the database such that no entries are recorded.

VII. DRAWING PREPARATIONS

A. SUPPLIES

- 1. Random number generator (computer program or alternate method).
- 2. Drawing checklists and certification forms.
- 3. Database containing all of the entries registered at www.coloradolottery.com or through the Colorado Lottery's Mobile Scratch Application during the drawing eligibility period and up to the drawing deadline.

B. PERSONNEL

The Drawing Team will consist, minimally, of the Lottery Drawing Manager or designee and Colorado Lottery Security Personnel.

1. Drawing Manager Responsibilities:

- a. Ensure all necessary equipment and supplies are available and in good working order.
- b. Ensure that all required personnel are present, briefed, and prepared to conduct the drawing.
- c. Ensure that all required documents, checklists, and certification forms are completed in a timely manner.
- d. Supervise staff in their drawing assignments.
- e. Ensure that the drawing is under camera for Colorado Lottery security purposes.
- f. Using a random number generator, select the winning entry or entries.
- g. Halt the drawing if anything improper is observed.
- h. Approve continuation of the drawing once an observed problem is corrected.

2. Independent Auditor Responsibilities:

- a. Observe all aspects of the drawing and bring any improprieties or irregularities to the attention of the Drawing Manager or designee.
- b. Examine equipment and supplies (pre- and post-drawing) to ensure operation will not compromise the integrity of the drawing.
- c. Assist in the examination of selected entries.
- d. Halt the drawing if anything improper is observed.
- e. Inspect and sign certified drawing documents.

- f. Provide a report to the Drawing Manager or designee to certify that the drawing has been held in compliance with all applicable statutes, rules, and guidelines.
3. Colorado Lottery Security Personnel Responsibilities:
 - a. Security Personnel must be present for all public viewings.
 - b. Observe all aspects of the drawing, ensuring that nothing is tampered with.
 - c. Assist in the examination and validation of each entry.
 - d. Oversee verification of winner identification and eligibility.
 - e. Halt the drawing if anything improper is observed.

VIII. DRAWING PROCEDURES

- A. The Drawing Team will assemble at the drawing site on the date and time determined by the Drawing Manager or designee.
- B. The drawing may not proceed until the appropriate personnel described in Section VII.B. are present.
- C. The Drawing Team will inspect the drawing equipment to ensure it is operating properly. The equipment should show no signs of tampering or any other condition that might compromise the integrity or fairness of the drawing.
- D. The database will consist of uniquely numbered entries that include registration information for the person who submitted the entry.
- E. The Drawing Manager or designee shall utilize a random number generator, as described in Section VII.A.1., to select entries within the "from-to" range.

Tuesday, December 8, 2026, Drawing: There will be one (1) drawing conducted on Tuesday, December 8, 2026, during which eleven (11) winners and twenty-eight (28) alternates will be selected across four (4) distinct prize tiers in the following sequential order:

1. Tier 1 (Grand Prize): The entry corresponding to the first (1st) entry selected will be the Tier 1 Grand Prize Winner. The next four (4) entries drawn will be Tier 1 alternates in the order selected.
 2. Tier 2: The entries corresponding to the next two (2) entries selected will be the Tier 2 Prize Winners. The next six (6) entries drawn will be the Tier 2 alternates in the order selected.
 3. Tier 3: The entries corresponding to the next two (2) entries selected will be the Tier 3 Prize Winners. The next six (6) entries drawn will be the Tier 3 alternates in the order selected.
 4. Tier 4: The entries corresponding to the next six (6) entries selected will be the Tier 4 Prize Winners. The next twelve (12) entries drawn will be the Tier 4 alternates in the order selected.
- F. Once the entries have been selected, the Drawing Manager or designee will create a certification document of the names drawn to be placed into the drawing file.

- G. Should it be necessary for the Colorado Lottery to conduct a subsequent drawing after the official drawing, a Drawing Team will reassemble.
- H. Should any member of the Drawing Team observe the occurrence of anything unusual during the drawing process that cannot be immediately corrected and may affect the validity of the drawing, that member may immediately halt the drawing proceedings. The Drawing Team shall attempt to resolve the issue and continue the drawing. In the absence of a resolution, the Drawing Manager or designee shall attempt to contact the Colorado Lottery Director, Deputy Director, Security Director, and/or Marketing Director, in that order. The decision of the contacted Director is final. Should the decision of the Director be to halt the drawing, the Drawing Team shall immediately secure all entries, equipment, and supplies until the drawing can recommence. An Incident Report must be completed by the Drawing Manager or designee and include the drawing forms.
- I. Following completion of the drawing, the Drawing Team will inspect and secure the equipment.

IX. DETERMINATION OF WINNER

- A. A reasonable attempt will be made to contact the person contained in the registered entry. If an entry is deemed preliminarily eligible at the time of the drawing, but the Colorado Lottery is unable to contact the person for any reason (e.g., telephone number or email address is incorrect or no longer in service) within five (5) business days, the prize is awarded to the alternate(s) in the order drawn. At the Drawing Manager's discretion, the timeframe may be extended.
- B. The person will have five (5) business days after being notified of the selection of their entry to contact the Colorado Lottery and claim their prize. At the Drawing Manager's discretion, the timeframe may be extended.
- C. If the winning entry contains more than one name, one individual must be designated to receive the prize, and all other named individuals will be required to execute a Relinquishment of Rights Form. The Colorado Lottery must receive all completed forms within five (5) business days from the date of the claim. The entry may be deemed ineligible if any required form is incomplete, missing, or delayed.
- D. Should the winning entry be deemed ineligible for any reason, the first alternate shall replace it as the winning entry. This entry will then be subjected to the same eligibility requirements, and should it also be deemed ineligible, replaced by the second alternate. This process will be repeated until an entry has been determined eligible and certified as the winner.
- E. In the event there is an inconsistency or insufficient information as to the person(s) entitled to the prize, the Colorado Lottery Director or designee shall initiate an investigation and withhold all winnings until such time that the Director or designee is satisfied that the proper person is awarded the prize.
- F. The Colorado Lottery Director or designee shall make all final decisions regarding the eligibility of entries and/or participants.
- G. Prize Refusal and Forfeiture: A selected winner may formally refuse the prize by notifying the Colorado Lottery in writing. A prize may be refused or forfeited only before it is officially claimed. Once a prize claim has been processed and finalized by the Colorado Lottery, the prize cannot be refused, surrendered, or forfeited under any circumstances. If a winner refuses or forfeits the prize prior to claiming, or fails to execute the required claim forms

within the designated five (5) business days, the prize will be deemed forfeited, and the next eligible alternate in the sequential order drawn will be awarded the prize.

X. FULFILLMENT OF PRIZE(S)

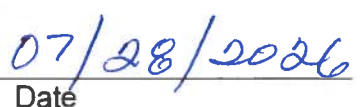
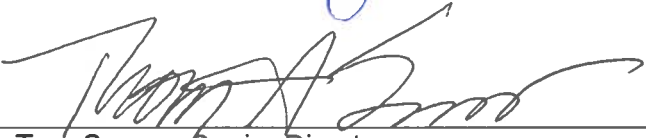
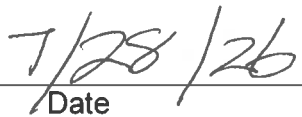
- A. Prize winner eligibility in the **\$5 BRONCOS BLITZ** Internet Promotional Drawing is subject to any and all applicable State of Colorado and Colorado Lottery Statutes, Rules, and Regulations regarding participation in Colorado Lottery Games.
- B. By entering this drawing, you are allowing the Colorado Lottery to display your first name, last initial, and city on the Colorado Lottery Website if your entry is selected as a winner.
- C. All ticketed prizes, event credentials, and travel vouchers will be delivered to the winner digitally via email or through the designated Denver Broncos/NFL mobile ticketing applications. No physical paper tickets or paper passes will be issued. Winners must possess a compatible smartphone and valid email address to receive and utilize the prize assets.
- D. The prize is non-transferable, non-refundable, and cannot be redeemed for cash or substituted for any other product or service.
- E. Tax Liability and Reporting
 - 1. Lottery-Paid Taxes (U.S. Citizens & Resident Aliens): For winners classified as U.S. citizens or resident aliens for tax purposes, the Colorado Lottery will pay the required federal withholding tax of 24% and State of Colorado withholding tax of 4.0% based on the gross value of the Grand Prize. These payments are considered additional taxable non-cash prizes and will be included in the total prize value reported to tax authorities.
 - 2. Lottery-Paid Taxes (Nonresident Aliens): In accordance with federal and state regulations, prize payouts to winners classified as Nonresident Aliens (NRA) are subject to a flat federal withholding tax of 30% and a State of Colorado withholding tax of 4.0%. These payments will likewise be treated as taxable non-cash prizes and included in the total reported prize value.
 - 3. Winner Responsibility: Any additional federal, state, or local taxes, or other financial obligations resulting from prize acceptance, are the sole responsibility of the winner. The Colorado Lottery does not calculate or account for individual tax situations.
 - 4. Tax Reporting: All prizes awarded in this promotion are considered taxable income. The Colorado Lottery will issue the appropriate IRS reporting form (e.g., Form 1099-MISC or Form 1042-S for Nonresident Aliens) to each winner and file it officially with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and the State of Colorado. The reported amount will reflect the total fair market value of the prize plus the value of all taxes paid on the winner's behalf.

XI. DISCLAIMER REGARDING BRONCOS AND NFL EVENTS:

The Denver Broncos Team, LLC d/b/a the Denver Broncos Football Club is acting solely as the prize provider and branding partner in connection with the Drawing and is not responsible in any way for administering or conducting the Drawing.
